Honeyville Residents, It is time to renew your dog licenses for 2018.

This year we are offering Honeyville citizens a chance to purchase dog tags through the mail, drop the information by City Hall and leave it in our drop box, or come in during office hours and purchase the tags you need. Attached are forms you can fill out with your information and your dogs' information. In order for Honeyville City to issue dog tags we need to have all the correct and current information. It is required that you show proof of rabies shots, Honeyville City will need to have a copy of this to keep in Honeyville City's files.

Honeyville City has seen an increase with dogs running at large, including dog bites. Honeyville City would like to remind the community there is an animal ordinance that needs to be followed by citizens who choose to own animals. Regulations are in place to help protect the community while allowing citizens the joy of owning animals in Honeyville. If you have any questions on animal rights and regulations please contact Honeyville City Hall.

ANIMAL REGULATIONS, FEES AND PENALTIES:

Unlicensed dogs or failure to license dogs

- First offense: \$25
- Second offense: \$50

Animals running at large

- First offense: verbal warning
- Second offense: written warning
- Third offense: \$25
- Fourth offense: \$50
- Fifth offense: \$75

Vicious animals at large

- First offense: written warning
- Second offense: \$25
- Third offense: \$50
- Fourth offense: \$100 (animal will be destroyed)

Dog bite fines and quarantine of animals

- First offense: \$50 with 14 day quarantine
- Second offense: \$100 (animal will be destroyed)

Animals in prohibited places (Parks, Cemeteries, posted areas)

- First offense: verbal warning
- Second offense: written warning
- Third offense: \$25
- Fourth offense: \$50
- Fifth offense: \$75

Excessive barking dogs

- First offense: verbal warning
- Second offense: written warning
- Third offense: \$25
- Fourth offense: \$50
- Fifth offense: \$75

City Impound Fees

- \$25 initial fee for any animal picked up
- \$10 each day per animal for up to 3 days, after which the animal will be taken to Brigham City Animal Shelter

All dogs within Honeyville City must be leashed or kenneled. All dogs within Honeyville City must be licensed. Before a dog can be released from the city kennel the owner must purchase dog licenses and pay all fees. Citizens may only be issued two tags per house, no exceptions. If you live in Rural Residential or Residential Zones you may ONLY have two dogs. If you live in Agriculture Zoning having five acres or more and you would like to have three or more dogs, you must apply for a kennel license. DECEMBER 31, 2017 YOU WILL RECEIVE \$1.00 OFF EACH
DOG TAG.**

**RABIES CLINIC WILL BE FEB. 10, 2018 AND DOG TAGS WILL
BE DISCOUNTED ON THAT DAY.**

JANUARY 1, 2018 – MARCH 31, 2018 fees will be as follows:

- spayed (altered) females and neutered (altered) males \$8.00
- not spayed (unaltered) females and not neutered (unaltered) males \$13.00

AFTER MARCH 31, 2018 fees will be as follows:

- spayed (altered) females and neutered (altered) males \$16.00
- not spayed (unaltered) females and not neutered (unaltered) males \$26.00

KENNEL PERMITS are \$30.00. Three or more dogs need a kennel permit; you must apply and go before Planning Commission and City Council for approval.

LIFE TIME TAGS are \$50.00, with no refunds or transfers. Replacement tags are \$5.00 each.

Honeyville City has regulations for all animals. If you plan on having animals on your property please contact City Hall to find out what zoning regulations are currently in place.
